PRACTICE DIRECTION FOR ALL FAMILY MATTERS AT THE OCJ BRAMPTON
RELEASED MARCH 22, 2022

PARAGRAPHS 1-7 OF THE NOTICE TO PROFESSION DATED NOVEMBER 29/21 IS REVOKED AND REPLACED BY THE DIRECTION OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE OCJ DATED MARCH 18/22 WHICH SETS OUT MODES OF APPEARANCE IN FAMILY COURT AFTER APRIL 4/22.

THE SAID DOCUMENT IS POSTED ON THE PUBLIC WEBSITE OF THE COURT.

In the transition period it is recognized that counsel and parties may have matters scheduled for virtual hearings in some courts and in person attendances in others. Counsel or parties must advise the court of any potential conflicts and the court will do whatever can be done to ensure that matters in other courts or other court buildings are not double booked. The goal will be to ensure that counsel and parties will be able to call into virtual hearings from their home or office and still be able to attend at any required in person matters.
